Weight: 6 - 10 kg

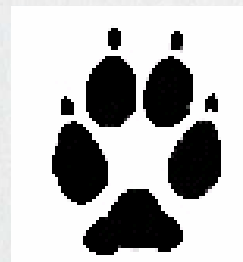
Lifespan: up to 15 years
